# The Alpha and Omega



# Revelation 1:4 refers to YAHWEH:

John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace [be] unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne.

The clue lies in verse five which states:

And from Jesus Christ, [who is] the faithful witness, [and] the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood.

Yahshua who has been made the express image of His FATHER also has the authority to grant these free unmerited gifts justly on whomever He chooses to favor. It can therefore correctly be stated that whatever Yahshua does comes from the FATHER and whatever YAHWEH does comes through the Son. Therefore, by way of clarification, Revelation 1:4,5 could be read and correctly so:

Grace and peace be unto you from YAHWEH and from Jesus Christ.

The first one who is unnamed in this verse is our Heavenly FATHER YAHWEH.

## Revelation 1:8 refers to YAHWEH:

! am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the

ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

It is readily understandable, that the Alpha and Omega and the beginning and the end are referring to YAHWEH as the rest of the verse states: "Saith the Lord which is and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

#### Revelation 1:11:

Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send [it] unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

In this verse the words "I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last" are not found in the most ancient manuscripts and are therefore spurious, having been added without authorization from the original writers who were guided entirely by YAHWEH'S Holy Spirit. For this reason, almost all modern translators omit these words and begin verse II thusly, "Saying, what thou seest write in a book...."

### Revelation 1:17.18 is Yahshua:

17 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last;

18 I [am] he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

And as the toes of the feet shall be part of iron and part of clay, a part of the whole kingdom shall be strong and the other part shall be fragile.

#### The clarification:

And whereas you saw iron combined with a becoming dressing of clay, they shall exchange pledges of security among the races of men but it will be evident that there will exist no such security of a real union with their attachment of one with the other even as iron does not in any way fuse with clay.

#### The clarification:

And whereas you saw the feet and toes part of sherds of clay taken from a potter and part of iron, it shall be a divided kingdom but its main hardness shall be in the iron. Forasmuch as you saw iron combined with a becoming dressing of clay.
